Isi Okwu: I na_enweanya ukwu maka na enwerekwa M obi oma?

Jesu gwara Umuazu Ya si: "Alaeze eluigwe di ka otu nwoke nwere ubi vain, onye upur n'isi ututu, ichota ndi oru o ga-etinye n'ubi ya. Mgbe ya na ndi oru ahu kwubiri na o ga-akwu ha otu m kpuru ego n'ubochi, o zigara ha n'ubi ya. Mgbe elekere itolu gasiri, o pukwara hu ndi ozo ebe ha guzo na nkiti n'Oma-ahia. O wee si ha: 'Jeenu ruoro m oru n'ubi m. Ihe o bulu ziri ezi ka m ga-akwu unu.' Ha wee jee. O pukwa ozo n'elekere iri na abuo na n'elekere ato n'ehihie, meekwa otu aka ahu. "Ihe di ka na elekere ise nke mgbede, o pukwara hu ndi ozo ka ha guzo na nkiti. O wee si ha: 'Gini mere unu ji guzo n'ebe a kemgbe taa n'arugh i oru?' Ha zara ya si: 'N'ihi na o dighi onye o bulu goro anyi oru!' O si ha: 'Gawanu n'ubi m!' Ma mgbe o ruru mgbede, onye nwe ubi ahu gwara odibo na-elekotara ya ubi anya si: 'Kpokota ndi oru, kwuo ha ugwo oru ha; malite na ndi ikpeazu ruo na ndi bu uzo.' Ndi biara oru n'elekere ise nke mgbede putara, a kwuo onye o bulu n'ime otu m kpuru ego. Ma mgbe ndi buru uzo bido oru biara, ha chere na a ga-akwu ha ugwo kariri nke ndi ozo. Ma ihe onye natara, ka ibe ya natara. Onye o bulu natara nani otu m kpuru ego. Mgbe ndi bu uzo ntara ego ha, ha tamuru ntamu si ogaranya ahu nwe ubi: 'Ndi a biakpere azu ruru oru nani otu elekere. Ma l meela ka anyi na ha hara otu - anyi bu ndi sitere kemgbe chi boro, doliwa ndoli di n'oru; anwu nile chara n'ubochi taa chara anyi n'isi!' Onye nwe ubi zara otu n'ime ha: 'Enyi m, gini ka m ji mejoo gi? Ihe mu na gi kwuru, o bukwa na m ga-akwu gi otu m kpuru ego n'ubochi? Nara ihe ruuru gi lawa. 25TH SUNDAY REFLECTION



We are constantly seeking things that appeal to our hearts, bodies and souls; be they, friends, children, life partners, monies, status, titles, property and so forth. Man's needs are insatiable and we hardly get tired of seeking for new things until we are stopped by death. However, it is only God that we can seek and find once and for all if we sincerely seek Him in Spirit and in Truth. The prophet Isaiah makes this clarion call for us to sincerely seek God now in order to find Him before it might be too late and the doors of grace be shut on us. 'For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as is the Lord our God whenever we call on Him'? Deut. 4:7.

The truth is that we will find Him if we seek Him with our heart and with all our souls. (Deut 4:29) This invitation is extend to those who have gone astray due to sin and are afraid to come back. It is also extended to those who live more on the flesh and have little or no time for the soul.
